Miami Children's Health Plan considers hepatitis A vaccine a medically necessary preventive service according to the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

Miami Children's Health Plan has partnered with local County Health Departments within Miami Dade, Monroe, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee, and Indian River County to offer Hepatitis A Vaccines to adults. If you believe your patient is at risk for contracting Hepatitis A, please direct the patient to visit their local County Health Department.

The County Health Department will conduct necessary testing to determine if the patient meets the criteria required to receive the Hepatitis A Vaccines. Please be mindful these services are to only be administered by the County Health Department.
